On the west coast, there are six Provinces, namely: Ranong, Phang-Nga, Phuket, £l Krabi, Trang, and Satun. The west coast of Thailand has a narrow continental shelf and £l deepens offshore. Inshore, areas within three km have an average dept of about three m. It £l has a slightly wider area in the north and a narrow area in the south; the latter area £l comprising mangroves and sea grasses. The bottom for the most part is sand, mud and coral £l remnants. Tidal currents and along shore flows dominate the water circulation along the £l Andaman Coast. The water movements vary with the monsoon period, nearshore surface £l water generally move northward during the northeast monsoon and southward during the £l southwest monsoon. The water of the northern region (Ranong to Phuket) has a high salinity £l (32.9-33.4 ppt) due to deep sea upwelling, while the southern region (Phuket to Satun) has a lower salinity range (32.0-32.8 ppt) due to the influence of surface run-off. The temperature range along the Andaman Sea Coast is 27.6-29.3 \$\mathbb{k} \mathbb{k} \mathbb{C}.
